

## TauRIS Windows Setup (version 8.11 or 1.41)

Set PC to TauRIS 8.11

Select **Club**

Select Add

Enter Club number

Tab

Enter Club name

Save

Select **Fancier**

Select Add

Enter Flier number

Tab

Enter Loft name or Flier name

Tab

Enter Latitude and Longitude if you have the coordinates. If the coordinates are not available enter 0 (zero) in each box.

Save

Select **Pigeon**

Select Add

Enter Nation: AU, IF, CU

Tab

Enter Year: (last two digits of the year)

Tab

Enter Federation: (your club's initial's) (4 digits only)

Tab

Enter the band number

Tab

Enter Sex: (C or H)

Tab

Enter Color: (4 digits only) (blue bar = BB)

Tab

If you are entering a series of sequential band numbers, in the COUNT Field you enter how many sequential bands you want to add. Otherwise leave it at 1.

If you make a mistake in entering the bird

Highlight the bird you **want to change**

Select Pigeon

Select Alter – This will allow you to change the sex or color of the bird

Select Save

If you make a mistake in the band number – you must **delete the bird** and re-enter

Highlight the bird you want to change

Select Pigeon

Select Delete  
Select Delete

To transfer data from the old system to the new system.

Try:

#1

Connecting your clock to PC

If you are using Ver 8.8 set your terminal to 3

If you are using Ver 8.9 set your terminal to 8

Set your PC to TauRIS 8.11

Select Communication

Select Get loft (Terminal to PC)

This should upload your stock loft to the PC

Then verify that your terminal uploaded to the PC by checking the club, fancier, and pigeons for that clock.

Then Select Terminal

Select 1 Fancier Load

Unplug the power supply to the cradle (if using the maxx Clock)

Place terminal in cradle

While holding down the number 6 button press the right arrow button

This will download the new program into your clock.

Then on the PC

Select Communication

Select Send Loft (PC to Terminal)

This downloads your stock back into your clock.

#2

On your PC copy the Club, Fancier, and Pigeon file folders from TauRIS 8.8 or TauRIS 8.9 to TauRIS 8.11.

If #1 and #2 do not work then you will need to input each flier and pigeon as described above.
